

This plant was first noticed in the Botanical Register for 1838, p. 45 of the miscellaneous matter, with the following memorandum: --To the cultivators of bulbous plants this fine species will form a welcome addition. It is very nearly related to the Paneratium ringens of the Flora Peruviana, out of which Mr. Herbert has formed his genus Elisena, and, like it, is a native of Peru. It was obtained from Lima by Richard Harrison, Esq., of Aighburgh, near Liverpool, and it blossomed in the stove of that gentleman in May, 1838. The leaves are much like those of an Amancaes; the flowers are of a delicate semi-transparent white, and are remarkable for their long weak sepals, which are rolled...
